NAC 445A.605 Application for permit: Required financial information

1. An applicant for a permit to operate a water system shall submit the following financial information with his or her application to permit:
- a. A copy of the budget which projects for 12 months, the fixed and operating expenses of the water system, including taxes, depreciation and emergency services for the area to be serviced by the system. **Attach as a separate document.**

- (1) The daily operations of the water system, including the cost of monitoring the system;
