No Exposure Application Process

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) application process for the No Exposure Waiver is an electronic application process done through our Notice of Intent. The following are the steps on how to apply for the No Exposure Waiver.

1. Click on the Notice of Intent Link
2. Create a New Login (at the bottom of the page)
3. Once created, you will be automatically entered into our system
4. Click agree to the terms and conditions on the main screen
5. Click apply for a NEW PERMIT
6. Answer the 11 No Exposure Questions
7. Fill out the Facility Information Form

*Name of Receiving water is whatever entity receives the rain or snow runoff
(e.g. Storm Drain, Truckee River, Las Vegas Wash, Lake Mead etc.)

8. The next page fill out the Owner/Operator Information (you will need your federal tax-id)
9. You may add additional contacts if you wish, or click submit
10. If you qualified for the No Exposure Waiver, it will ask if you want to apply for one, **click yes and print the confirmation page.**

THE COMPLETED REQUEST MUST BE MAILED TO NDEP WITH AN ORIGINAL SIGNATURE.

11. If you do not qualify for the No Exposure Waiver, it will lead you directly to the Permit Confirmation page. It is a \$200.00 fee for the permit with an annual fee \$200.
